

## Guidelines from abroad

### *Short description & aim*

In this short personal contribution you are encouraged to share experiences about your internship abroad. The aim is to provide students with a personal view on doing an internship abroad and to share experiences with living and working in a new environment.

### *Maximum length*

550 words

### *Language*

British-English

### *Format*

- ◆ MS Word .doc format

### *Not allowed*

- ◆ Using unnecessary abbreviations. Only standard abbreviations are allowed. Introduction of a new abbreviation in the text should be preceded by the full term it stands, except for standard units of measurement.

### *Structure*

Please note that, although the focus of the article can be freely chosen, the abroad article must contain the following components:

- ◆ Name
- ◆ Host institution, city, and country
- ◆ Main topic of your internship

Besides, think about discussing the main differences between the internship now and the previous internship here in Utrecht, your motivation for studying abroad and choosing this particular internship, positive aspects and unforeseen obstacles, or personal experiences. Please try to incorporate advice or useful tips for students considering to do their second internship abroad, regarding accommodation or scholarships for example.

### *Picture*

Please include a picture of yourself in the highest quality possible (preferably 150-300 dpi). We prefer formal photographs over holiday pictures.

Please, keep in mind that readers from different backgrounds have to be able to understand your contribution.
